Key Event Requirements (KERs) System

We are happy to inform you that the much talked about FEI Key Event Requirements (KERs) System will be launched to cover all FEI events from 1 January 2024.

All information outlining the KERs, how they are monitored and followed-up on is available on [Inside.FEI.org](https://www.insidefei.org).

The KER system relies largely on existing FEI post-event reporting processes. As such, KER reporting is carried out online either through existing web-based reports (Veterinary Delegate, Jumping Foreign Judge and Chief Steward and Endurance Technical Delegate), or in the absence of online reporting, by way of the relevant official being sent a dedicated email with links to submit their responses.

FEI sets criteria for participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes, Horses and Officials in FEI Events

As you may have seen in the News today, the FEI Board has approved the criteria and conditions that Athletes, Support Personnel, Horse Owners and Officials from Russia and Belarus must fulfil in order to be allowed to return to participation in FEI Events. The document outlining the **FEI Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes, Horses and Officials in FEI Events** can be viewed [here](#) on [Inside.FEI.org](https://www.insidefei.org), and you will find a press release (including the procedure and deadlines/timelines) [here](#).

Since some of the criteria, such as the use of national anthems, flags, emblems and identifiers will come under the responsibility of National Federations, Event Organisers, Officials and other support personnel at FEI Events, we urge all stakeholders to consult the complete document mentioned above and to share this information with your colleagues.

We also take this opportunity to remind Officials that the measures prohibiting FEI Events from being held in Russia and Belarus remain in place. No FEI Events organised in Russia and Belarus can be entered in the FEI Calendar for 2024. No Officials' courses as well as any other FEI activities will be held in Russia and Belarus for the time being and all FEI Solidarity projects in Russia and Belarus remain frozen.
